The Research Associate I will perform social science program development and evaluation tasks across the lifespan of projects, from conceptualization and grant writing, to formative research and program creation, to outcome evaluation and reporting. More specifically, the person in this position will:

- Supervise and/or participate in data collection and analysis from public health and public policy perspectives.
- Supervise the work of more junior research staff.
- Make site visits, conduct interviews, and supervise field research.
- Maintain budgets and manage resources for segments of projects under his/her responsibility.
- Participate in writing final reports and presenting results to external audiences.
- Actively publish in scholarly journals.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

Qualifications for this position include: 1) a doctorate in public policy, public health, psychology, economics, or a related social science field, or equivalent experience in a similar research organization; 2) experience with fundraising, publication preparation, and/or project management; 3) a strong publication record; 4) excellent writing abilities and data collection and analytic skills; and 5) proficiency with statistical software packages, such as SAS.
